Sounds typically used:	• Tend to use: p, b, t, d, m, n, w
May have difficulties with:	All other sounds including: k, g, s, f, sh, l, r, etcLong complex words are difficult
By three	
Sounds typically used:	• Tend to use: p, b, t, d, m, n, w, h
May have difficulties with:	All other sounds including: k, g, s, f, sh, l, r, etcLong complex words
By three-and-a-half	
Sounds typically used:	 Tend to use: p, b, t, d, m, n, w, h Possibly starting to use k, g, s, f
May have difficulties with:	 sh, z, v, ch, j, l, r, th 2 consonants together, like fl, sp, sm, gr, str Long complex words
By four	
Sounds typically used:	 Using: k, g, s, f, p, b, t, d, m, n, w, h Using 's' clusters: sm, sp, sn, st, sk
May have difficulties with:	 sh, z, v, ch, j, l, r, th Difficulty with other consonant clusters: fl, fr, gr, gl, str, spl Some long complex words
By four-and-a-half	
Sounds typically used:	• Now using: sh, ch, j (in addition to other sounds listed above)

Sounds typically used:	Now using I (in addition to other sounds listed above)
May have difficulties with:	r, thConsonant clusters involving r or I: fl, gr, etc
six	
Sounds typically used:	 Using all sounds except 'th' Using 3-consonant clusters: spr, str, spl
May have difficulties with:	• th
seven	
Sounds typically used:	 Using all sounds except for regional accent variations (eg: think → "fink")
