



## Help with travel costs

If you've been referred for NHS treatment by your doctor or dentist, and you are on a low income or receive benefits, you may be eligible for help with the cost of travelling to and from your appointments.

## Help with costs

You may be eligible to get help with public transport travel costs if you receive:

- Income support
- Income-based jobseeker's allowance
- Income-related employment and support allowance
- Pension credit guarantee credit

You may also be eligible if:

- You're entitled to or named on a valid NHS Tax Credit Exemption Certificate
- You're named on a valid HC2 certificate (includes travel by your dependent children)

## Making a claim

If you think you're eligible and would like to make a claim:

- Speak to a member of the reception team at the outpatient clinic you're attending
- You will need proof of your income or benefits, receipts or tickets for your journey
- Fill out a HC1 and/or HC5(T) form and send it to the address shown on the form
