

Hints to help 'word finding'

Peoples names

- If they are people you see very often try to have their pictures with names besides them to jog your memory. Have a look often to refresh yourself
- Try to remember and picture the social context in which you see people e.g. pub, church, club, choir etc.
- Think about other people that you associate with that person
- Think of what sound the name begins with
- Think about if it rhymes or reminds you of something else to help you try and remember

Object names

- Think about what the object looks like and feels like e.g. big/small, soft/hard
- Think about its colour
- Does it make any noise?
- Where do you see it outdoors/indoors, what room?
- What does it do or what do you do with it?
- What other things do you associate with it?
- Is it made up of other words put together?
- Does it rhyme with something?
- Is it a long name or a short name?
- Think about if it belongs to a group of things e.g. fruit, furniture, clothes

Don't panic if the name still escapes you, it will probably come back to you later!
