Referral Criteria for Assessment

- The resident has reduced range of movement in any joint (e.g. a contracture) or
- The care home staff are having difficulties with positioning the resident in bed due to pressure damage
- The resident must have had a recent review of their pain relief if this is an issue
- The resident is not currently under the care of a private OT/physio or the community-based neuro rehab team (CBNRT)
- The resident is not predicted to be end of life (within the next 2 weeks)
- The resident is not receiving respite care

Useful information to include in your referral:

- If the resident has a contracture, is this impacting on their bed positioning and ability to sit in a chair?
- Does the resident have a swallowing difficulty/are they prone to aspiration pneumonia which you think may be as a result of their positioning?
- Is pain an issue for your resident?
