



Reference management software

What is it?

Reference management software helps you keep track of information you read, including books, articles, reports, or websites.

It is particularly useful if you are:

- working on an assignment
- doing research
- undertaking a systematic review

Examples of popular software include EndNote, RefWorks, Mendeley, and Zotero.

Why use it?

- saves time tracking your references and typing references manually
- keeps your references organised all in one place
- ensures your references are presented in a consistent and accurate style

How do I get it?

If you are enrolled with a university or higher education institute, ask their library about reference management software. Many can provide the paid version of software to students for free.
