

Going for an X-Ray

Why am I being sent for an X-Ray?

Following your assessment with an Advanced Physiotherapy Practitioner (APP), you have been sent for an X-Ray to further assess if there is a structural cause for your symptoms.

What is an X-Ray?

An X-ray is a widely used diagnostic test to examine the inside of the body by forming an image. It's a very effective way of looking at the bones and can be used to help detect a range of conditions.

Are there any risks?

X-rays do involve exposure to a small amount of radiation. Depending on the body part being examined, the radiation dose is equal to between a few days and a few years of exposure to the levels that we all receive from natural background radiation. You should speak to your APP if you have concerns about the risks of X-Rays.

If you are, or think you may be pregnant, you must tell the radiographer before being X-rayed as there could be a small risk to an unborn child.

How long will it take?

The process of taking the X-Ray will only be a few minutes. The radiographer might have to take the X-Ray in different positions, depending on the body part.

How long will I wait to receive my results?

- Once you have had the X-Ray, the images will be viewed and reported on by a Consultant Radiologist. We receive most results within 2 weeks, but this can take up to 4 weeks
- When we receive your results, the APP will contact you by letter or telephone to discuss your results and agree upon the recommended management/ treatment plan
- We might also require to discuss those results with the Spinal Orthopaedic Consultant and await results of other investigations, if requested, prior to contacting you
