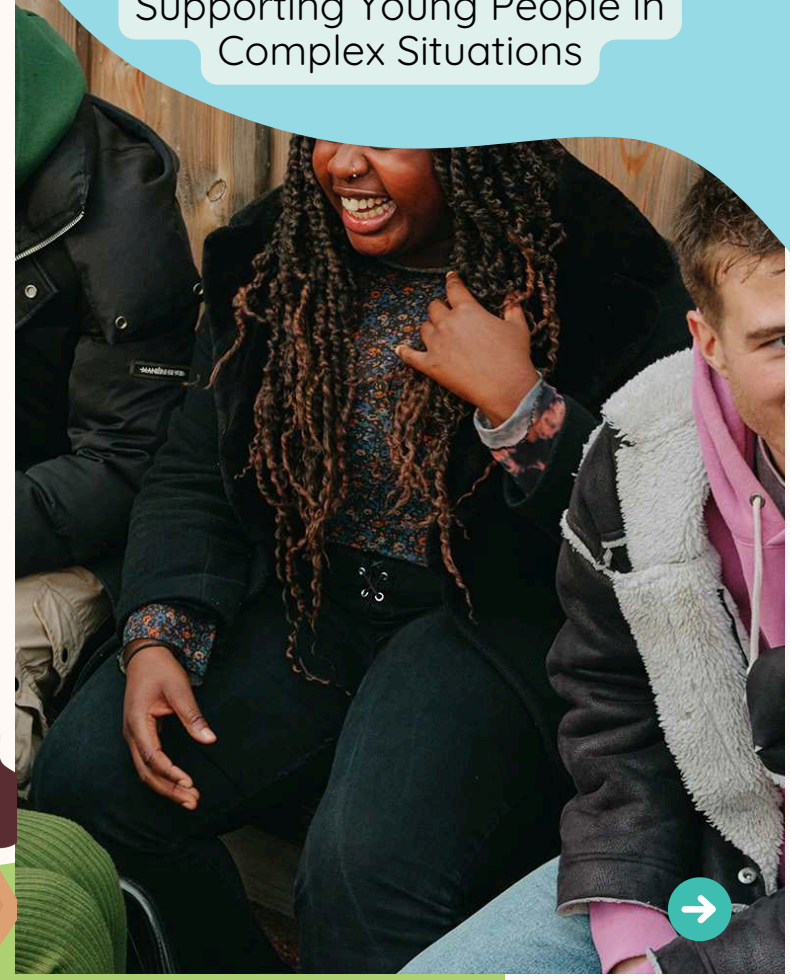

ABOUT THE LINK TEAM

Sometimes, no single service can meet all these needs, which can make it harder for professionals to support you. We're here to help with a range of needs like education, health, social care, and more. There may be concerns about your emotional well-being, mental health, or neurodevelopmental needs.

The Link Programme brings people together to give you the help you need.

Why Have I Been Referred?

- ➔ You may be facing challenges with your physical and/or mental health.
- ➔ You may have longer-term needs, like autism, learning disabilities, or both.
- ➔ Standard treatments haven't fully met your needs so far.
- ➔ You may be dealing with tough family or social situations, like changes in your family, loss, or experiences of inequality.

Discuss Your Situation

The Link Team will review your support so far, recommend steps, and/or connect you to the right services.

Further Assessment

The Link Team may meet with you to explore your challenges and needs. This could be with a psychologists, psychiatrist or mental health professional, and may include your home, school, and social environment.

4 WAYS

we may get involved

Your journey is unique, and the Link team will provide the most appropriate support for you! You may experience one or a mix of support options.

Develop A Care Plan

The Link Team and other professionals will work together to understand your story and create a care plan for you.

Direct Management Of Your Care

Sometimes the Link Team will manage your care with other professionals and monitor your care plan, including psychological, educational, occupational, and youth work support. You will help develop your care plan.
